

Consent

1. Purpose of data processing

The Mercedes-Benz Group is committed to the highest standards of integrity in its business practices and transactions and wants to ensure that its suppliers have the same values. Within the Due Diligence process the procurement department of Mercedes-Benz Group AG as central unit is responsible for the performance of the due diligence check on the supplier and therefore requests the consent. The performance of a Due Diligence aims to evaluate the risk of the prospective business. All gathered information are used for evaluation purposes, for assessing potential risks, to define remediation measures and to identify suppliers with existing integrity concerns. The need of a Due Diligence is based on the internal Mercedes-Benz Group guidelines, which are derived from relevant regulations including legislation with an international impact, e.g. US Foreign Corrupt Practices Act of 1977, UK Anti-Bribery Act 2010, Sanctions and Embargoes as well as conventions of the International Labour Organization (ILO).

3. Data processing

Mercedes-Benz Group processes the following data for the aforementioned purposes:

- a) Your company name including brand name, address data, country
 - b) Your personal details including first name, family name, nick name, date of birth, position, country
 - c) Potential hits about you on official sanctions lists, adverse media hits, watchlists which are relevant for the due diligence.
- All obtained data including data from external providers are based on publicly available sources. The data and the respective database are classified as confidential and will be treated this way by Mercedes-Benz Group.

4. Data transfer/ Data processing by third parties

Mercedes-Benz Group uses external service providers (adverse media providers, sanction list providers, research providers) to perform Due Diligence checks and processes the personal data in accordance with existing European data protection legislation.

5. Rights of the signee

The processing of the personal data is based on the signees' consent pursuant to Article 6 (1) lit. (a) of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). The declaration of your consent is voluntary. We will process your personal data based on this consent for the aforementioned purposes only until you revoke your consent or object to the processing. The revocation of your consent does not affect the legality of the processing or other legal processing carried out on the basis of the consent until revocation. You have the right at any time to obtain information about your personal data, the right to have it corrected or deleted, the right to limit its processing, and the right to make a complaint to us or to a supervisory authority. You are free to exercise your right to data portability.

To withdraw the consent please contact the Controller on the above stated contact details or the respective entity you are doing the business with or intend to do the business with.

6. Duration of storage

Mercedes-Benz Group will store the personal data for no longer than necessary for the purposes for which it is being processed. The storage is limited to a period of not more than six years starting from termination of the contract date. In case of cancellation before the contract is signed, the storage is limited to period of not more than six months starting from the cancellation date
