



How to subscribe to notification e-mails?

IBL vuser data Personal settings (1002) Step 1: To subscribe to **notification e-mails**, open the **Personal Settings (I002)** function in the User Data section.

This function can be used to (de)activate user-related notification emails of the various applications.

Step 2: A list of available notification e-mails is displayed in different tabs per application.

By **selecting the checkbox**, the individual notification e-mails can be subscribed to.

With a click on **Save** afterwards, the settings are applied.

The selected notification e-mails will then be sent to the stored e-mail address(es) displayed below the list when the respective event occurs.

Notice: Subscription to certain notification e-mails is preset.
